






Overnights in accommodation establishments in Estonia (mil.)



Overnights in accommodation establishments in Estonia (thous.)




Change in overnights in accommodation establishments, 2022/2019 (thous.)



Overnights by country of residence (%)



In 2022 domestic and foreign tourists spent 5.95 million overnights in accommodation establishments in Estonia (-15% or -1.02 million compared to 2019).





In 2022, Finnish tourists spent 1.09 million overnights in accommodation establishments in Estonia (-28% or -426,000 compared to 2019).



Overnights of Latvian tourists in accommodation establishments, thous.

Since December 2021, Latvian overnights have been significantly higher in all months (except May) than in the same period in 2019. In 2022, Latvian tourists spent 323,000 nights in accommodation establishments (15% or 43,000 more than in 2019).







Overnights of Russian tourists in accommodation establishments, thous.

Although from the beginning of summer 2021, travel from Russia was slightly freer, the restrictions imposed by Russia continued to apply until 14.07.22. On the other hand, Estonia introduced new restrictions on entry from August and September, the effects of which can be seen in the statistics from October. In November and December, their overnight stays were more than 90% lower than in the same period in 2019.



Overnights of Swedish tourists in accommodation establishments, thous.

The recovery from Sweden has been slow, and the fact that there is only 1 ship sailing from Tallinn to Stockholm instead of the previous 2 must be taken into account. In 2022, Swedish tourists spent 80,300 nights in accommodation establishments (50% or 82,000 fewer than in 2019).











Overnights of Polish and Lithuanian tourists in accommodation establishments (thous)





Overnights of domestic tourists in accommodation establishments, thous.

Domestic tourists spent 3 million nights in accommodation establishments in 2022 (17% more than in 2019). Domestic tourism reached its previous record in 2021, but in 2022 it exceeded that level by a further 12% - despite the fact that, as restrictions came to an end, Estonians began to actively travel abroad, they also travelled domestically more than ever before.




