• NAUTICA - Tallinn's sea gate, with almost 60 shops that focuse on internation brands and youth fashion.







Top 5 culinary gift ideas

Our small country is filled with large, pure and fresh flavours. The local flavour palette includes the entire world- we are curious and open to try new things. Food is usually the first thing, that comes to our mindes, when traveling, so if you are looking for options that are more original, memorable and quintessentially Estonian, here are some suggestions.

• Bread from MUHU PAGARID— we Estonians take our rye bread seriously. Worlds different from the typical supermarket rye, this traditional staple is closer to what our ancestors have been baking for centuries.

Location: Kopli 1, Tallinn, Balti jaama market

Sugar rush from KALEV- Nothing hits the souvenir sweet spot quite like sweets. In Estonia's case, the ones to seek out are those made by the nation's long-time confectionery, Kalev, a company that traces its roots back to the early-1800s and has become synonymous here with high-sucrose temptation.

 HONEY- If you happen to spend your Christmas with an Estonian family, then there's a high likelihood that you'll be gifted a pot of honey sourced from a local beekeeper. Honey is widely used to sweeten up life and boost the immune system.

Location: widly sold in Balti jaama market and local stores

 Põhjaka SEA-BUCKTHORN SCHNAPPS- sugary, rum-based liqueur works well as a dessert drink and is often added to coffee to give it extra kick. A healthy, but less known, alternative.

Location: Tallinna Kaubamaja, Gonsiori 2, in city center

 VANA TALLINN- if you're a traveller who likes to pick up a bottle of the local tipple from each country you visit, the name you need to know is Vana Tallinn.
